

**Front impact**

Structures in the dashboard represented a potential hazard to the knees and femurs on both the driver's side and the passenger's.

**Side impact**

In the side impact, forces transferred in an unrealistic manner up the test dummy's spine, reducing the forces recorded by the instrumentation in its chest. The car was penalised for this.

**Child occupant**

An inadequate warning was given against using a rearward-facing child restraint in the front passenger's seat. Moreover, the label was positioned on the windscreen and might not be on replacement parts.

**Pedestrian**

Neither the bumper nor the leading edge of the bonnet scored any points for the protection they offered to pedestrians.
